

END-USER LICENCE AGREEMENT FOR "ABSYNTAX FRAMEWORK". IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS LICENCE AGREEMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE CONTINUING WITH THIS PROGRAM INSTALL. This End-User Licence Agreement ("EULA") is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or a single entity) and Managing Infrastructure Information Limited (MIIL) for MIIL's "Absyntax Framework", which includes installation software, associated software components, media, printed materials, and "online" or electronic documentation (collectively known as the "Software Product"). By installing the Software Product, you agree to be bound by the terms of this EULA. This licence agreement represents the entire agreement concerning the Software Product between you and MIIL, and it supersedes any prior proposal, representation, or understanding between the parties. If you do not agree to the terms of this EULA, do not install or use the Software Product.

The Software Product is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties, as well as other intellectual property laws and treaties. The Software Product is licensed, not sold.

## 1. GRANT OF LICENCE.

The Software Product is licensed as follows:

### (a) Installation and Use.

MIIL grants you the right to install and use copies of the Software Product on your computer running a suitably and validly licensed copy of the operating system for which the Software Product was designed. You may only use the Software Product with a valid and activated licence key.

### (b) Licence Keys

Licence keys encapsulate your specific usage rights concerning the components within the Software Product and said rights may differ between licence keys. Licence keys may be obtained from the websites of MIIL and its affiliates or by arrangement with MIIL. Licence key activation requires an internet connection.

### (c) Licence Limitations
